Although funded by the Tertiary Education Commission (TEC), the funding has been reduced gradually as the pandemic has seen a decline in local student numbers.

Due to several coincidences, the business has been unprofitable in the last few years (decrease in students with

pandemic as well as the time and money spent on developing the new school which started last year, etc.) and the activities have been temporarily suspended since July 2022.

The business is very reluctantly being offered for sale due to the owners' cash flow restrictions; however, the owners would consider different options.

The PTE industry has many barriers to entry, and this business might suit someone who wants to enter in the market straight away and at the highest level (Cat.1) and/or other education / training businesses that wishes to add these two schools to their portfolio.
